## ON AND OFF CAMPUS - ACHIEVEMENTS GALORE

### *Scholastic Achievements*

- 5 Students **Keshav Gupta**(AIR-19), **Prajwal Jha**(AIR-224), **Subhranshu Singh**(AIR 647), **Satyendra Banjare**(AIR 70) and **Ojas Krishnani**(AIR 758) qualified **Kishore Vaigyanik Protsahan Yojana-2015**, a National Program of Fellowship initiated and funded by the Department of Science and Technology, Government of India.
- **Keshav Gupta** of class XII was the **National topper** in **National Standard Examination in Physics**, conducted by the **Indian Association of Physics Teachers (IAPT)** on 27th November, 2016 and qualified for **INPhO (Indian National Physics Olympiad)**. He also qualified for **INChO (Chemistry)** and **INAO (Astronomy) Olympiads**. He qualified for the second level conducted by **Homi Bhabha Centre for Science Education (HBCSE)**. (Students desirous of representing India in the respective International Olympiads are required to qualify these exams)

(Applicants are assessed not only on the basis of SAT and TOEFL score, but also for their passion. MIT is currently ranked number one in the world for its Engineering programmes.)

10 ounces frozen Raspberries, thawed  
2 tablespoons quality honey,  
12 ounces unsweetened lemon-lime water,

Repeat with Cantaloupe puree and Raspberry puree. Garnish with Kiwi slices.
